

Melton cloth

From Real Tennis balls to duffel coats, different weights of Melton cloth can be found in lots of places that demand high wear including in the manufacture of military uniforms. Originally developed in the Leicestershire town of pork-pie-famous, Melton Moubray, the originally dense 'twill' weave and use of 'fulled' wool (that makes it thicker and more compact by eliminating any impurities and subsequently subjecting the woven fabric to moisture, heat and friction) makes it one of the most hardwearing upholstery fabrics on the market, whilst its felt-like texture means it less susceptible to fraying.

The classic Melton fabric we now use on all our upholstered pieces is woven in the UK from 100% pure new wool and is fire retardant.

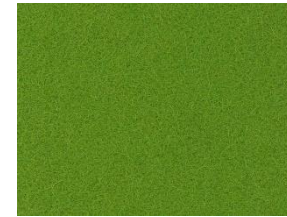

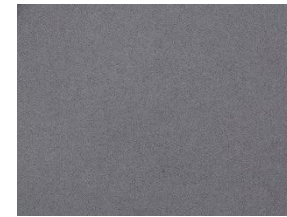

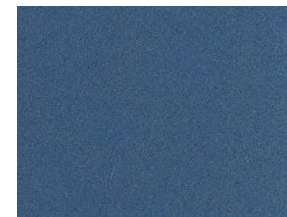
